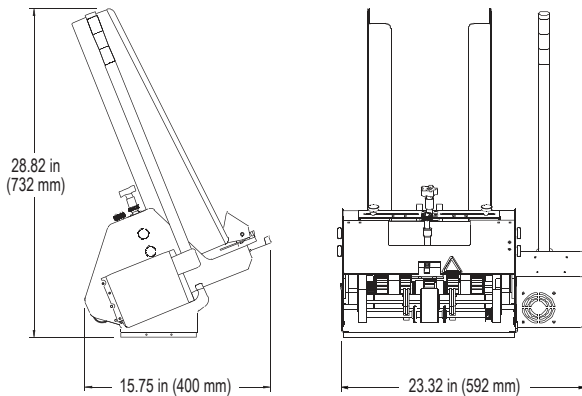




Pro Series - Feeder/Dispenser Model ST-1450
